**Report about the Second Meeting at Bremen, April 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> 2014**

**April 22<sup>nd</sup>**

Arrival of groups, meeting at dinner

**April 23<sup>rd</sup>**

Morning: **First Meeting session** at Diakonisches Werk Office

After welcoming of the guests, Jürgen Stein from Diakonisches Werk Bremen introduces the meeting program – agenda proposal – which is agreed by all participants

Review of “Mosaics of Life“ results or “work in progress”: Each group show the films resp. Powerpoint presentations produced at each place. They show introductions of volunteers and disabled persons from each place, what is important for them and what are their wishes for the future.

Agreement: the presentations / videos are shared and published on the homepage after some last additions or ameliorations (files to be send to the coordinator until end of June)

Presentation of Bremen “Friedenstunnel” (Peace tunnel) project and its mosaics - <http://www.rembertitunnel.de/> - by Mrs Regina Heygster. She presents the work on the dilapidated tunnel, which is adorned now by symbols of the religions present at Bremen and other decorative elements (work in progress) and the general information and dissemination for of the Friedenstunnel initiative which works a lot with disabled persons and their day centers. English information leaflets are shared and should be published on the partnership homepage



13.00 Lunch and at Wichernhaus Day Centre

After lunch: **Second meeting session** with information about the work at Wichernhaus (day center for adults with psychic disabilities) mosaic activities at Wichernhaus which produce a mosaic which will be used as decorative element at the day center. Printouts are given to all participants.



Late afternoon: visit in to Bremen City Centre, its mosaics and sights, dinner at restaurant "Bremische Wirtschaft". Evening activities in chosen by participants.

**April 24th**

Morning: Meeting at Bremen Main Station, travel to Bremen-Lesum by train. Sepiszentgyörgy delegation may travel directly from accommodation to Bremen-Lesum.

Third meeting session at Stiftung Friedehorst: Welcome at Friedehorst Foundation area, general information about the various services offered by the foundations institutions - visit to mosaics in the area, mosaic activities together with the guest of the various groups of the Friedehorst Day Centre (Tagesförderstätte) for mental and multiple disabled adults.

Each group produce a number of "pieces" which are connected to a mosaic.

lunch at Friedehorst cafeteria

Early afternoon: **Fourth meeting session** at Friedehorst foundation

The mosaic pieces produced in the morning session are put together, the work is photographed and each participant could keep the "piece" he/she has produced and take it home as souvenir.



Meeting with the press (paper Weserreport), interviews with participants. General information about the history of Friedehorst Foundation, which were used by German world War II airforce as a base and was transformed to a social institution ("Home of Peace") after the war.

Late afternoon: **Fifth meeting session** at Diakonisches Werk office: Discussion of partnership organization issues
